

# Newham Cricket Club Development Plan 2022 – 2027



### 1. Introduction

Newham Cricket Club was re-established in 2008 at Flanders Field, in East Ham, starting with a Colts' organisation. In its first full season in 2010 the Club had 12 fixtures. In 2012 the Club added an adult section of 2 Saturday teams. In 2016, following the addition of a third Saturday XI the Club hosted over 100 adult and colts' fixtures with a similar number of away matches.

The club fields teams at under 9, 11,13,15,16 and 4 Saturday adult teams. Flanders field offers an immaculate 10 wicket square and a second 4 wicket square which will be available for the 2022 season. Colt's training and coaching is on Tuesday evenings with matches on Sunday mornings. Adults train on Thursday evenings

The club was accepted to play in the Hamro Foundation Essex League system in 2020

This dynamic growth would not have been possible without the support and infrastructure of Bonny Downs Community Association (BDCA) which manages Flanders Field, having brought it back into life in the early 1990s.

BDCA raised the capital for the continuing development of the site which now includes two artificial surfaces, two grass squares, 3 all-weather nets, a multi-use practice area and improved pavilion.

This development has been possible through the strategic intervention of a partnership between LB Newham, Essex CCC and ECB, initially focussed on identifying facilities in Newham and now a borough cricket development plan harnessing the resources of Newham's primary and secondary schools and further education establishments, park and street cricket and clubs.

### 2. Vision

To promote health, wellbeing, educational and vocational achievement through community participation in cricket. We will do this by:

- Making cricket affordable to our members and potential members alike
- Hosting summer and winter cricket programmes for the youth of our borough to learn and play the sport if cricket
- Introducing members to the benefits of learning a skill in maintaining a cricket green throughout the season
- Promoting opportunities to volunteer at the club and learn new skills in coaching or playing the game of cricket



### 3. Aims

To offer top class competitive cricket and facilities at all levels to members of the local community

To identify, harness and develop all young cricketers so they can contribute to the game of cricket at all levels and play a central role in club cricket life

To ensure that the club is an integral part of the local community, contributing a valuable service to all sections of that community, developing club members, supporters, and volunteers

To develop and strengthen a structure and pathway for women and girls actively to participate in and follow cricket

To promote cricketing opportunities for disabled people

To develop and promote cricket for black and ethnic minorities

To develop strengthen senior playing teams providing positive role models to all club members, leading to achievement and success

To implement partnerships with local schools, colleges & universities, and informal organisations

To ensure that all members, playing and non-playing, abide by the ECB Code of Conduct which incorporates the Spirit of Cricket and by the Laws of Cricket

To ensure a duty of care to all members of the club by adopting and implementing the ECB Safe Hands Policy for Safeguarding Children

To ensure a duty of care to all members of the club by adopting and implementing the ECB Club Inclusion and Diversity Policy
